Job Purpose Summary

- The Junior Geologist will be a valued member of the geology team, responsible for a wide array of tasks aimed at delivering high quality, innovative products and services to clients in a timely fashion. The geologist will work under the direction of the Chief Operating Officer and will be assigned tasks within the scope of the department. This individual will exhibit the ability to work in team settings or independently, exhibit leadership, interpersonal skills, as well as strong verbal and written skills.
- The Junior Geologist must be comfortable and able to work in the field on a consistent rotation in a variety of areas within Saskatchewan and Internationally.
- The individual must display a broad understanding of geology including industry best practices and trends. Specific knowledge of potash, uranium, and oil would be an asset.
- Professionalism and strong work ethic are imperative as the Junior Geologist will be a representative of North Rim.

Key Responsibilities

- Field work – pre-spud meetings, core retrieval supervision, observing the drilling / coring processes and field logging of core.
- Responsible for detailed geological and geotechnical logging of a variety of core samples.
- Overseeing and performing sampling core.
- QA/QC review of digital or hard copy datasets.
- Responsible for drill core photography and assisting in moving and stacking core.
- Hole summary reports, generation of cross-sections, data entry or any other reasonable task that may fall into the above listed categories. Assist with the compilation, organization and formatting of data and reports.
- Submission of certain data to the SK government on behalf of clients, and distribution of datasets to the client or other consultants.
- When required, attend client meetings / teleconferences, email or phone communication.
- Weekly updates to the Project Team Leader.
